Prophetic Patterns

We have been going thru patterns and cycles in the bible the reveal “things” that are in Gods Word about what happens when a nation or it’s leaders turn their back on God.

God will take his hand off of a nation so they will have no where to turn. God raises up kings and gets rid of them so His people turn back to Him. He has already told us in His Word what would take place.

Ecclesiastes 1:9 Good News Translation (GNT)

9 What has happened before will happen again. What has been done before will be done again. There is nothing new in the whole world.

Ecclesiastes 1:9 Amplified Bible (AMP)

9 The thing that has been—it is what will be again, and that which has been done is that which will be done again; and there is nothing new under the sun.

Ecclesiastes 1:9 King James Version (KJV)

9 The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun.

Tonight I want to continue going thru God's Word of warning regarding America during these last days or End of Time. That warning is thru the prophetic patterns in the bible and the parallels that we can see throughout history as nations repeat what has already been.

One of those parallels or patterns is between ancient Egypt and modern day American, specifically as it relates to Washington DC and our leadership.

Then we are going to look at Israel being a picture of the church in ancient Egypt and what they did in Egypt. Then we will look at what God is doing in America - tying all this together.

First, America is a melting pot of many nations and these are the empires of prophecy: Egyptians, we have many Egyptians living here. Assyria or Syria, we have many Syrians living here in America as well. We have Persians and people from Iran who live here. Remember these are the empires of bible prophecy. There are many people from Greece, Iraqis, people from Rome which are Italian who come from Italy.

Understand that America has all the descendants from the major empires of bible prophecy. America is also one of those unique nations that has patterns like ancient Rome, like ancient Israel, like Babylon and even like ancient Egypt.

Right now in history, America is more closely aligned or parallels that of ancient Egypt. Now, Back in 2008, there was an election in November for our Presidency. Then in January 2009 there was the inauguration.

Throughout the synagogues that week of the inauguration there was something interesting about the Torah portions being read. As a reminder, the Torah is the first 5 books of the Old Testament and a portion of each of those books of the Torah is read every week.

The week of the inauguration in the synagogues they were reading from the book of Shemot (in the Hebrew) or the book of Exodus (in English). This is the beginning of the story of the Exodus. In this particular passage of the Torah they were talking about the death of Joseph and that generation and how there arose a king that did not know Joseph.

Exodus 1:8 King James Version (KJV)

8 Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph.

Exodus 1:8 Amplified Bible (AMP)

8 Now a new king arose over Egypt who did not know Joseph.

Now, in the hebrew this doesn't mean the new king didn't know who he was literally, it means he didn't regard him or didn't respect him.

Remember, Joseph is why Egypt had become this super power that it was. So the new king did not regard or respect what made Egypt great. He actually began to see Gods people in Egypt as a threat.

Exodus 1:9 Amplified Bible (AMP)

9 He said to his people, Behold, the Israelites are too many and too mighty for us [and they outnumber us both in people and in strength].

9 And he said unto his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we:

He knew they were outnumbered and said they are more and mightier than we are, so he went to his advisors to devise a plan on how to keep Gods people down.

10 Come on, let us deal wisely with them; lest they multiply, and it come to pass, that, when there falleth out any war, they join also unto our enemies, and fight against us, and so get them up out of the land.

11 Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

The inauguration in January 2009 coincided with the Torah portion which included this new king who didn't know or recognize or respect Joseph. He identified Gods people as the enemy and he began along with others in his administration or government to implement policies that were designed to keep Gods people subjected to and in the land to be their tax base.

One of the things he did was implement tax masters, this is pharaoh and his administration who are doing this. Now this is found in Exodus 1 and in most translations it will say task masters. But, when you read in the Word when it says “task master” in english, the first time and only time it uses a completely different hebrew phrase that would be rendered tax masters.

What the new king does is implement these heavy tax burdens upon the people. Now, this is why, before this, the Egyptians had given their freedom away to pharaoh, had sold themselves to pharaoh in exchange for grain.

Genesis 47:18-21 King James Version (KJV)

18 When that year was ended, they came unto him the second year, and said unto him, We will not hide it from my lord, how that our money is spent; my lord also hath our herds of cattle; there is not ought left in the sight of my lord, but our bodies, and our lands:

19 Wherefore shall we die before thine eyes, both we and our land? buy us and our land for bread, and we and our land will be servants unto Pharaoh: and give us seed, that we may live, and not die, that the land be not desolate.

20 And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

21 And as for the people, he removed them to cities from one end of the borders of Egypt even to the other end thereof.

Genesis 47:18-21 Amplified Bible (AMP)

18 When that year was ended, they came to [Joseph] the second year and said to him, We will not hide from my lord [the fact] that our money is spent; my lord also has our herds of livestock; there is nothing left in the sight of my lord but our bodies and our lands.

19 Why should we perish before your eyes, both we and our land? Buy us and our land in exchange for food, and we and our land will be servants to Pharaoh. And give us seed [to plant], that we may live and not die, and that the land may not be desolate.

20 And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field because of the overwhelming severity of the famine upon them. The land became Pharaoh's,

21 And as for the people, he removed them to cities and practically made slaves of them [at their own request], from one end of the borders of Egypt to the other.

So up to this point in time, Gods people were not owned by pharaoh. So what the government did was implement these heavy tax burdens that puts them in a very vulnerable position, they began to oppress them with hard labor. They would also take their male children (born of Gods people) and throw them into the river.

22 Then Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son born [to the Hebrews] you shall cast into the river [Nile], but every daughter you shall allow to live.

When you take the hebrew word Pharaoh and spell it out, it is comprised of 2 different words. The outer part or the beginning and last portions of the word means mouth. That is what you would see on the outside or outer part...man look on the outside. Because when he would speak, people would respond. Example: Yul Brynner said “so let it be written, so let it be done”.

So he speaks eloquently and how does he look on the outside ? He is adorned with a gold helmet and crown and in the center was a serpent. Now to look at him - he looks good - on the outside.

Now at the center of the word pharaoh or the heart of the word pharaoh is the hebrew word which means evil or wickedness. So, in his heart is wickedness but what people see on the outside is things that are attractive.

This is the serpent in the garden...

Genesis 3:1-15 Amplified Bible (AMP)

I Now the serpent was more subtle and crafty than any living creature of the field which the Lord God had made. And he [Satan] said to the woman, Can it really be that God has said, You shall not eat from every tree of the garden?

2 And the woman said to the serpent, We may eat the fruit from the trees of the garden,

3 Except the fruit from the tree which is in the middle of the garden. God has said, You shall not eat of it, neither shall you touch it, lest you die.

4 But the serpent said to the woman, You shall not surely die,

5 For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing the difference between good and evil and blessing and calamity.

6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good (suitable, pleasant) for food and that it was delightful to look at, and a tree to be desired in order to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate; and she gave some also to her husband, and he ate.

7 Then the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves apronlike girdles.

8 And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

9 But the Lord God called to Adam and said to him, Where are you?

10 He said, I heard the sound of You [walking] in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself.

11 And He said, Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten of the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?

12 And the man said, The woman whom You gave to be with me —she gave me [fruit] from the tree, and I ate.

13 *And the Lord God said to the woman, What is this you have done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled (cheated, outwitted, and deceived) me, and I ate.*

13 *And the Lord God said unto the woman, What is this that thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.*

14 *And the Lord God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:*

15 *And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.*

This serpent in the garden is repeated time and time again throughout scripture and history in general. Those who rise up against Gods people look good to most everyone else, but wickedness is in their heart.

These parallels that we see in ancient Egypt to America and not just recently or just one political part but this has been building for years and years and now we are here and seeing it played out before us.

So, pharaoh doesn't understand the hebrew people. You would have to be totally naive or willfully blind to what is happening in this country not to see that we have leadership in this country that is now anti Israel. Many decisions have been against Israel and there has been talks about sanctioning Israel because of decisions that many of the leaders in America don't agree with Israel.

Just to recap: There was a pharaoh who did not like or respect Joseph, this story was read about in the synagogue - the torah portion in 2009 the week of the inauguration.

The first thing that happened was, taxes were increased - that was the tax masters that we spoke about.

11 Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

Exodus 1:11 Amplified Bible (AMP)

11 So they set over [the Israelites] taskmasters to afflict and oppress them with [increased] burdens. And [the Israelites] built Pithom and Rameses as store cities for Pharaoh.

Now, this particular leader in Egypt passed a law to abort children...

22 Then Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son born [to the Hebrews] you shall cast into the river [Nile], but every daughter you shall allow to live.

What happened in 2009 was the new leader, our President reversed a law and opened up the doors to abortion all over. Partial birth abortions.

Now remember, God is revealing to us His Word. He is the same yesterday today and tomorrow. So when you study who He is and His characteristic you will see things or get revelation to what is currently happening and things to come.

Now, take the political out of this, don't think politics - I'm not a politician, I am a preacher. But see this from the prophetic perspective and understand how it works.

The pattern you see in Exodus brings us to this time. The next thing after the increased taxes, hard labor, abortion is plagues are going to be poured out. Now, remember, God allows that king or pharaoh to come to power.

God allows it to happen - we looked at several of those reasons why He allows “things” to happen over the last 3 weeks (repentance etc) Or lifts his hand of protection or the hedge.

Another reason is, God allowed this judgement or unrighteous ruler to be over them is that the Israelites or Gods people had become to assimilate into Egyptian culture. They had become so mixed up with what the Egyptians thought was important (idols) that they turned away from Gods Word. If God had allowed them to continue that way, they would of completely assimilated into Egypt's way of living and thinking and Gods people or Israel, would of disappeared.

6 For the Lord corrects and disciplines everyone whom He loves, and He punishes, even scourges, every son whom He accepts and welcomes to His heart and cherishes.

This goes back 3 weeks ago..warning, chastisement, judgement and then abandonment.

Proverbs 3:12 Amplified Bible (AMP)

Revelation 3:19 Good News Translation (GNT)

19 I rebuke and punish all whom I love. Be in earnest, then, and turn from your sins.

Speaking of the churches before Jesus returns - 4 weeks ago...

If God would not of punished them or corrected them by allowing these things to take place, Israel or Gods people would of lost sight of what God wanted them to do and never would of fulfilled His purpose for them.

So let's compare this to today. The troubling thing that is happening right now is not so much what is going on in the world or what the world is doing but what Gods people are allowing to come into their lives and churches.

Gods people are caving into what the world says is right and what the church is doing what the world want them to do about it. This is what was happening with Gods people were in Egypt but we're not suppose to be of "it" or like "it".

Romans 12:2 Amplified Bible (AMP)

2 Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you].

John 15:19 Amplified Bible (AMP)

19 If you belonged to the world, the world would treat you with affection and would love you as its own. But because you are not of the world [no longer one with it], but I have chosen (selected) you out of the world, the world hates (detests) you.

1 Peter 2:11 Amplified Bible (AMP)

11 Beloved, I implore you as aliens and strangers and exiles [in this world] to abstain from the sensual urges (the evil desires, the passions of the flesh, your lower nature) that wage war against the soul

God allows these things to happen, (kings to be raised up) to remind us who we are - we are His. We are to set ourselves apart.

When the plagues started to be poured out in Exodus Chapter 7-11, after the first 3 plagues you can see that God sets up a dividing line between His people and the Egyptians...why does He do this?

Because in the end, after the correction is done He wants us to know something...

Exodus 10:2 Amplified Bible (AMP)

2 And that you may recount in the ears of your son and of your grandson what I have done in derision of the Egyptians and what things I have [repeatedly] done there—My signs [of divine power] done among them—that you may recognize and know that I am the Lord.

Exodus 10:2 Good News Translation (GNT)

2 and in order that you may be able to tell your children and grandchildren how I made fools of the Egyptians when I performed the miracles. All of you will know that I am the Lord.”
