#### Chapter Twenty Two – Part II

#### Point

- 14                    **7.** A Christian on Fire will make sure they give an accurate picture of God/Jesus when they speak of him. Paul made sure that these Jewish people understood that the one they crucified like a criminal was really the "Just One".
- 15                    **8.** A Christian on Fire will understand their purpose for the Lord. Paul was told by Ananias that he would be a witness of Jesus to all he would meet.
- 15 - 16              **9.** A Christian on Fire will tell others while sharing the gospel that the first step of obedience to the Lord comes through Baptism.
- 17 - 21              **10.** A Christian on Fire will spend time in prayer. They will communicate openly with God about their concerns.
- 22 - 30              **11.** The Christian on Fire should use wisely whatever worldly tool (that does not break God's rules) to protect themselves from harm. In Paul's case, he used his roman citizenship to try and stop his punishment from the authorities. He did not just sit there and take the beating. Being Christian does not mean we are to be meek and mild to the point of death. God expects us to be as wise as the serpent.
